## Answer to, You make the call....

Point for your opponents! Players are responsible to call the balls on their side of the net. So, if your opponent returns a shot that you thought was out, until you hear that "out!" call, play the ball.

## Court Etiquette

Tennis has been around for a long time and there are some interesting rules of etiquette. I was asked to refresh everyone's memory on a couple key points.

### Crossing a court that someone is playing on:

Maybe this rule of etiquette finds its roots in that in many areas, players pay for a court by time, and it can be very expensive. The basic rule of thumb is that you don't want to delay or interrupt play if you have to cross someone's court. Most polite is if you can find a way to access your court without having to walk across another. Every court at the club has its own gate mainly for this purpose. Practically speaking though, at the club, the only times you will need to cross a court to get to another, is if you are playing on Courts 7 or 9. In such cases, wait off to the side until those playing on Court 6 or 8 have finished the point, say "excuse me" and then walk briskly through the court to delay play as little as possible. It is perfect if you can do it on a side change.
